THEATER ARTS

Students study theatre every day for four years and have the opportunity to earn an Arts Endorsed Diploma. After leaving our program they will be prepared for work in theatre at the college and professional level. Coursework includes Acting, Directing, Playwriting, Musical Theatre, and Technical Theatre. Students will go to see Broadway and off-Broadway shows and will work with professional actors and directors in their theatre classes.

FINE ARTS

Students will take daily art classes for four years. In the Visual Arts major, students will learn an array of techniques and media of the art field. Students are encouraged to work towards obtaining an Arts Endorsed Diploma. After four years students will have an art portfolio exhibiting their skill set as a growing artist. Yearly exhibitions are held at a downtown manhattan exhibition space where students and families can attend and revel in their artwork. Coursework includes: drawing, painting, mixed media, sculpture, murals, printmaking, and digital design. Students will visit museums and local partnerships to observe, explore and create.

CAPSTONE

College readiness program that exposes students to AP Courses throughout their four-year high school tenure. Scholars will complete a four-year study of Theatre to earn their Arts Endorsed Diploma and an Advanced Regents Diploma. In the 12th grade, students have the opportunity to apply for a 'capstone'; or internship in the Arts Field.
